GREENHOUSES

Ontario has the most vegetable greenhouses in Canada, covering almost 3,100 acres - or about 7,750 Canadian hockey rinks.

APPLES

Ontario is Canada's largest appleproducing province, growing about 35% of the country's apples.

Through research and innovation, plant breeders are constantly developing new fruit and vegetable varieties that will grow well in the Canadian climate.
